

GUIDING WITH TECHNOLOGY

Guides are permitted to use wireless transmission whisper systems. This does not include open audio loudspeakers. There is no guiding within any rooms unless stated otherwise, this includes where the guide stands outside the room and guides remotely.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If you are bringing a group to Stirling Castle, we recommend reviewing the below guiding information to ensure an enjoyable visit for both visitors and staff.

- Guiding is permitted in:
 - external areas of the castle
 - The Great Hall
 - The Chapel Royal
- Guiding is not permitted in:
 - The Palace Apartments,
 - The Stirling Heads Gallery
 - The Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Museum
 - The Great Kitchens
- Groups should be led through gateways as quickly as possible, and we ask that there is no guiding in queues. This will ensure that the experience of other visitors is not impacted
- It is the responsibility of the guide to keep the group together for the duration of the tour
- Children under the age of 16 must stay with an adult at all times
- Please show consideration to other guided groups on the site both when they are and are not guiding. This includes official Stirling Castle Guides
- Please arrange for your group to meet and gather before entering or leaving Stirling Castle by the Robert the Bruce Statue on the Castle Esplanade. If you require a meeting point within Stirling Castle, please arrange for your group to meet in the Outer Close

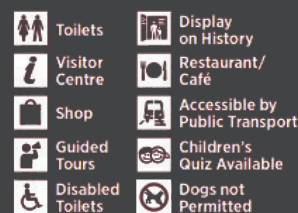
GETTING THERE
